

Summary

The programme YouthDOCs was carried out in Greece and Turkey between 2014 and 2016, and implemented a student-centred methodology, which included active learning techniques in student groups and utilized video and theatre documentation. Secondary education students from both countries were invited, in groups, to reflect on the negotiation, selection, production, recording and exchange of audiovisual messages (video and/or drama), messages which were related to issues they regarded as worthy of being preserved from their natural, human and social surroundings, and which they considered to be representative of their youth culture and identity. The outcomes of the programme were presented to the International YouthDOCs Conference "Video and Theatre Documentation: Recording Critical Aspects of Youth Culture in the Contemporary Reality", 18-19 June 2016, Nafplion, Greece.
